### JOHN 1:14-18

The U-Haul truck pulls up, the door opens, and a couple people jump out each side. The sign in the front of the house had read 'Sold' for a few weeks. Someone has moved into your neighborhood. They will walk their dog down the same sidewalks you walk yours. They will cut their grass in the summer sometime around when you cut yours . . . and the same with shoveling snow.
