1 CORINTHIANS 7:17-40

The Corinthian Church was planted by the Apostle Paul. They wrote Paul about several issues and either opened themselves up for feedback or directly requested it. One of the issues was that it was improper to have sexual relations. Paul corrected their position and laid out biblical principles for married couples and singles. He continues to write about when it is good to marry and when it is good to stay single. He shared his thoughts on the subjects guided by the Holy Spirit. He used a general argument over a variety of issues to stress the importance of finding one's satisfaction in Christ. He also addressed specific issues concerning marriage and singleness.
