

## 1 CORINTHIANS | HONORING THE LORD'S SUPPER

### 1 CORINTHIANS 11:17-34

The Corinthian Church needed order. The church faced issues that caused confusion and detracted from their worship. Paul would make it clear to them that God is not a God of confusion but a God of peace (1 Corinthians 14:33a) He commended them for remembering him and maintaining the teaching that he had passed on to them. However, he cannot commend them in their perversion of the Lord's supper. They had become fractured, selfish, and indulgent. They contradicted Christ's accomplishments and the very meaning of the Lord's Supper and their love feasts. How can a church avoid the mistakes the Corinthians made and honor Christ as they celebrate the Lord's Supper?
